Based on the conference, the Court hereby orders:

- 1. The hearing on the Blandin Trust's Petition for approval of 2009-2011 accounts and Stipulation to Discharge the Special Master and Approve Self-Reporting currently scheduled for October 30, 2014 is hereby continued to a future date to be determined by the Court upon recommendation of counsel;
- 2. Prior to the continued hearing, the Minnesota Attorney General's Office will coordinate a meeting or meetings with Special Master Peter Ulmen, community representatives and Blandin Trust and Blandin Foundation officials to review the proposed Stipulation to Discharge the Special Master and Approve Self-Reporting and discuss any community member concerns. The meetings should be scheduled at a time and place determined by the Attorney General's Office, Special Master Peter Ulmen, and Blandin Trustees and Blandin Foundation representatives and should be reasonably soon;

- 3. The Attorney General's Office will report to the Court on the scope and nature of any concerns and any efforts to address those concerns.
- 4. The Foundation agrees to publish this Order on its website and communicate it directly to interested community members, as appropriate.
